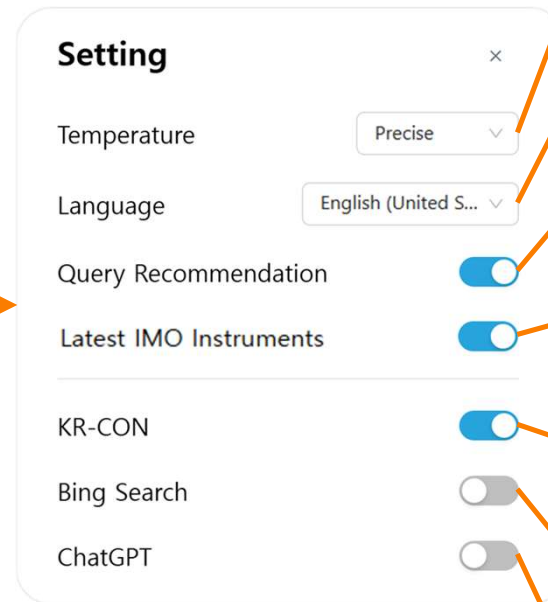
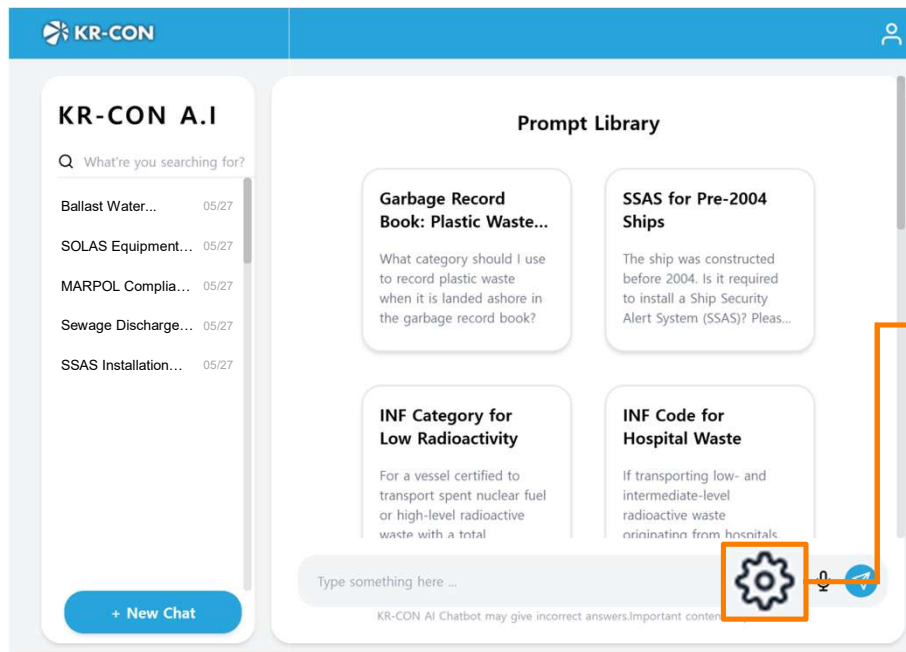

Hong Kong Convention Status

The Hong Kong International Convention for the Safe and Environmentally Sound Recycling of Ships, also known as the Hong Kong Convention, was adopted at a conference in Hong Kong, China, in May 2009. This convention aims to ensure that ships are recycled in a manner that does not pose unnecessary risks to human health, safety, or the environment.

As of today, May 29, 2025, the convention is not yet in force. It has been confirmed that the convention is scheduled to enter into force on June 26, 2025. This means that, while the framework and guidelines established by the convention have been in development and ratified by several key parties, they will become legally binding internationally after this date.

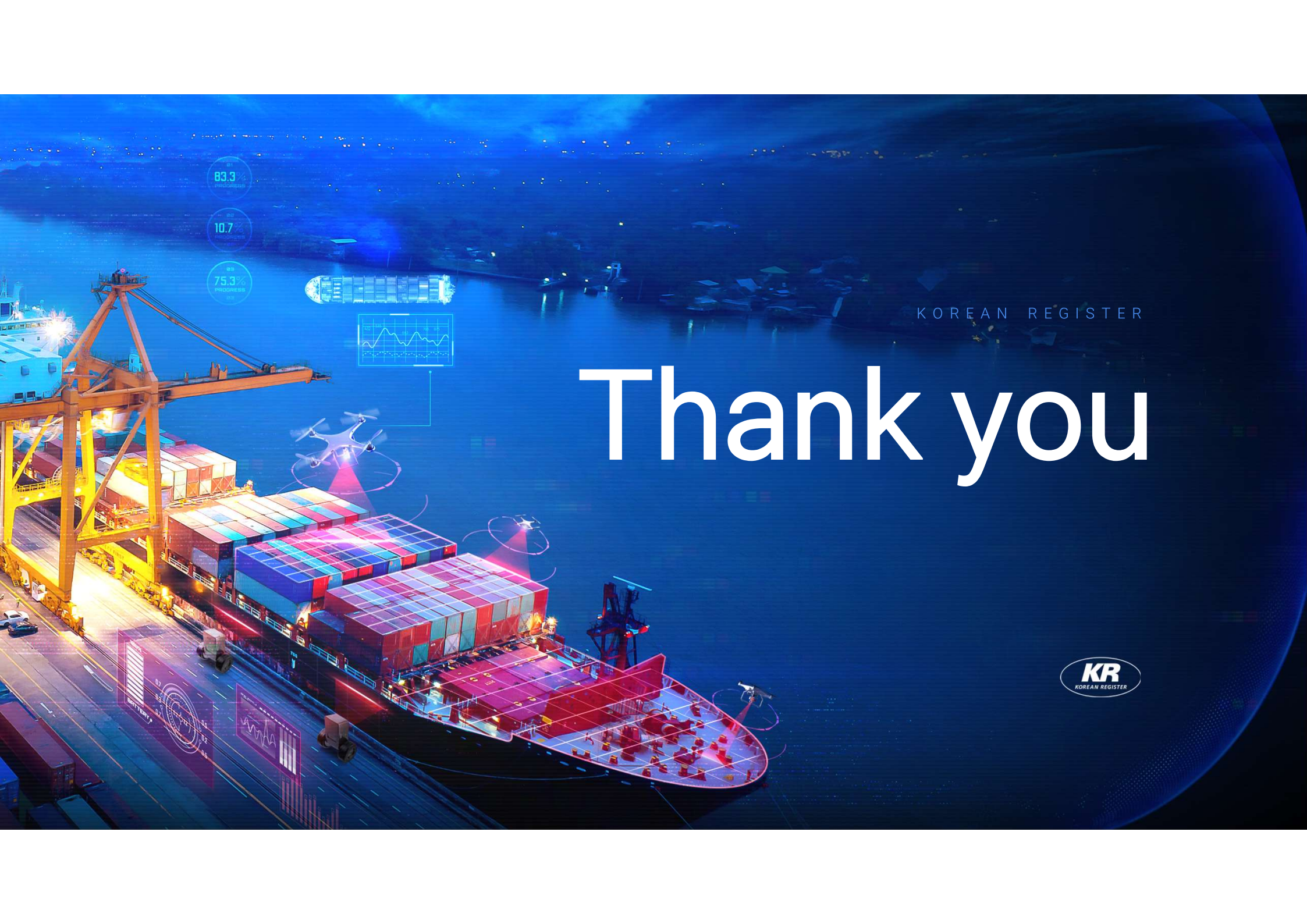
The convention's entry into force has been set for this specific date following sufficient ratification by member states, as stipulated by its terms. Numerous resources, including documents from the International Maritime Organization (IMO), verify that the effective date for the global enforceability of the Hong Kong Convention is June 26, 2025.
